The event takes place at Rockwell Park on Thames Street in Bristol, RI and will begin at 1:00 PM with the Blessing of the Fleet. There will be activities on the waterfront all day, including live music, beer & wine, the Blessing of the Fleet, a tradition Littleneck Boil prepared by local fishermen/women, and the much anticipated "Stuffie Competition."

The Stuffie competition will take place under the Festival Tent at 2:30 pm. **There is a \$25.00 participant fee to compete. Applications (see next page) are due by Friday, August 9th. We will only be accepting the first 20 applicants - so please don't delay in submitting the enclosed application!** The Bristol Harbor Festival Committee will be providing competitors with a bag of "Top Necks" or "Cherrystones" harvested by local fishermen. **You will need to pick up your bag of quahogs at the Harbormaster's Office, located in the Bristol Maritime Center, on Thursday, August 15 or Friday, August 16, anytime between Noon and 9:00 pm.**

On the day of the Festival, please arrive by 2:00 pm with at least five Stuffies to be judged. Any remaining Stuffies will be served to the festival attendees.
